Good luck with the annual Golden Easter Egg Hunt! (see my email and attached poster for details).

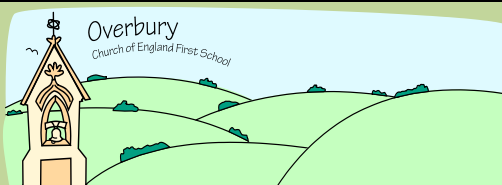

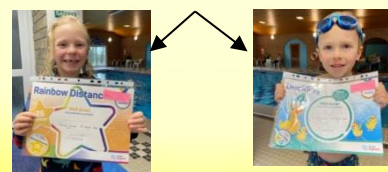

HANDi App: Information & Guidance on Common Childhood Illnesses

The App is free to download: Apple (App Store) Android (Google Play Store). The App provides advice & support for when children are unwell, with information about when and how to ask for help and gives simple advice for conditions in children such as: Sickness and Diarrhoea, high temperatures, 'chesty baby' illnesses (such as croup, asthma and wheezing) and general abdominal pains.
